SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall be lawful for the Mount Carbon and Port Carbon railroad company to increase their capital stock, from time to time, as they may deem expedient: Provided, That not more than two thousand shares, in the whole, of additional stock shall be created under the provisions of this act: And provided further, That no additional stock shall be created under the provisions of this act, unless the said company shall at an annual, general or other lawful meeting, have authorized the issue thereof; nor shall a certificate of any share of such additional stock be issued, until the sum of fifty dollars for the same shall have been actually paid into the treasurer of said company, in such instalments as shall have been directed by the president and managers thereof.*

Shinkle, late Harriet M. Cope, of the county of Philadelphia, and John W. Shinkle, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties*

released and discharged from all the duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.

AN ACT

For the relief of Ehler and Snyder, of Lancaster county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the auditor general be directed to examine the account of Ehler and Snyder, and their claim to per centage for work done to avoid the Columbia incline plane, and should any moneys be found unpaid from the original contract or estimates, he is authorized to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the amount, which shall be paid out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated. Auditor general to settle claim.
