To authorize the trustees of the Loller academy, in Montgomery county, to sell and convey certain real estate belonging to the said academy, and to invest the proceeds in landed security for the use of said academy.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met. and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That

Trustees empowered to sell. Ezra Walmsley, Charles H. Hill, Jesse Watson, Gove Mitchell, Joseph B. Yerkes, Hiram Reading, Asa Comly, John M. Yerkes and Harman Yerkes, trustees of the Loller academy, in Moreland township. Montgomery county, be and they are hereby authorized to sell and convey, in fee simple, a tract of about four acres of woodland, being the property of the said academy, at either public or private sale, and the proceeds thereof to invest in good land security for the benefit of the academy aforesaid: *Provided*, That before this law shall be operative, security shall be given by the said trustees, to be approved of by the orphans' court of Montgomery county, for the faithful application of the proceeds of said sale.
