A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act providing for the examination and settlement of claims for damage done by the construction of the Conneaut line of the Erie extension of the Pennsylvania canal," approved the tenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and required to examine the claims of Samuel M'Creary, for damage done to his woolen factory and dam, and of Constant W. Hicks, for damage done to his farm, by reason of a breach or breaches in the Conneaut line of the Erie extension, Pennsylvania canal; and also the claim of John A. Tracy, second, for damage done to his saw mill and water power therewith connected, by reason of the construction of said canal, under the provisions of the first, second, third and fourth sections of the act to which this is a supplement.

To change the time of holding the township elections in the county of Clarion.
