A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act appointing commissioners to view and lay out certain state roads," approved the twenty-seventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-four.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That John Musser, Michael Rudy and Peter Kline be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and mark on the ground, a road, if they shall deem the same necessary, from the corner of Jacob Rudy's land, in Hellam township, York county, in the line of the state road laid out in pursuance of the eleventh section of the act to which this is a supplement, (the said Jacob Rudy's land being that part of the land marked on the draft of said road as "widow Rudy's," lying north of said road, (to a point where the line which divides the lands of Jacob Rudy and George Dietz crosses the Columbia and York borough turnpike; the ascent or descent of which road shall at no point exceed more than five degrees from a horizontal line; and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall proceed to perform the duties assigned them by this act, on or before the first day of October next, and shall cause a draft of said road to be deposited in the several offices in which the draft of the original road, laid out in pursuance of said act, were directed to be deposited; and from thenceforth said road shall be, to all intents and purposes, a public highway, and shall be deemed and taken to be part of the original road laid out as aforesaid, and shall be opened and repaired in like manner; and that part of the original road commencing at the corner of Jacob Rudy's land aforesaid, in the line of the original road aforesaid, and terminating, at the end of said road, at Henry Sultzbaugh's tan-yard, in York county, aforesaid, shall be annulled and vacated, and its place supplied by the road hereby directed to be laid out.

SECTION 2. That the said commissioners, before entering on the duties of their appointment, shall be sworn or affirmed in like manner as is by existing laws prescribed for viewers of roads, and that they shall be entitled to like compensation, payable in like manner, as viewers of roads in other cases.
