AN ACT

Relative to the trust estate of Fidelia R. Hasluck, late Fidelia R. Van Dyke.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Fidelia R. Van Dyke, on the twenty-fourth day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, during her minority, executed an agreement with her intended husband Daniel L. Hasluck, and Henry V. D. Johns, as trustees, for the conveyance of her estate upon certain trusts, by which it was agreed, that when the said Fidelia should attain the age of twenty-one years, she should execute such other acts and deeds as might be necessary for the purpose of confirming, settling and executing said trust, et cetera:

And whereas, The said Fidelia has, ever since her arrival at the age of twenty-one years, refused to execute such other acts and deeds as is contemplated by the said agreement, for the purpose of confirming, settling and executing said trusts, declaring the said agreement to be prejudicial to her interest, and is desirous of having the absolute control of her own estate: therefore,

Trustee authorized to pay trust funds to Fidelia R. Hasluck.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* John L. Atlee, of the county of Lancaster, the present trustee of said Fidelia R. Hasluck, appointed by the court of common pleas of Lancaster county, be and is hereby authorized and required to pay over to the said Fidelia the amount of trust funds in his hands, fully and absolutely discharged from the trusts specified in the agreement of the twenty-fourth day of May, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.
