A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act incorporating the town of Laurenceville into a borough, passed eighteenth of February, eighteen hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, and the supplement thereto, as describes and fixes the boundaries of the borough of Laurenceville, be amended so that the boundaries shall be as follows:— Beginning at the bank of the Allegheny river, at a stake at the corner between the farms owned by Samuel Ewalt and Richard L. Ewalt; thence along the dividing line between the said farms to S. H. Keller's out-lot; thence along the north and east lines of said out-lot to the Pittsburg and Greensburg turnpike; thence along said turnpike westwardly, to the north corner of a range of building lots laid out on the south side of said turnpike by John Woolstayer, in his lifetime; thence by the east and south lines of said lots, until it strikes the line of Har-mar Denny's farm; thence down said line to a black oak stump, the original corner between John Ewalt and James O'Hara; thence along the present boundaries of the borough to a button wood tree on the Two Mile run; thence down the run to the turnpike bridge; thence across Har-mar Denny's land to the foot of Wainwright's island; and thence up the Allegheny river to the place of beginning.
