AN ACT

For the relief of Elizabeth E. Weaver.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the auditor general is hereby directed and authorized to settle the account Auditor general of the late Samuel Weaver, deceased, with his widow, Elizabeth E. to settle claim. Weaver, for money due to the said commonwealth, on account of tax on writs, et cetera, and that interest be only chargeable on the same from the first day of November last past; and that the said auditor general be authorized to receive the amount thus due to the said commonwealth, in such instalments as he may deem proper: *Provided,* The whole sum due be paid to the said commonwealth within seven years from the passage of this act.

AN ACT

To authorize the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church, in the borough of Milesburg, in the county of Centre, to sell certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the estate vested in Isaac Lee, John Hanson, Thomas M'Gee, Archibald Bathurst and John Hoover, trustees for the Methodist Episcopal church in Milesburg, Centre county, by the indenture of Christian Eaby and Catharine, his wife, bearing date the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, for a certain lot of ground situate in said borough of Milesburg, and marked on the general plan of said borough, as lot number one hundred and forty, be and the same is hereby vested in Isaac Lee, Archibald M'Mullin, David Jones, Charles G. Ryman and David Webber, the present trustees, and their Estate vested.

AN ACT

To confirm the title of Matthias Benzinger and others, to certain real estate.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Stryker, on the twenty-second day of February, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, by covenant under his hand and seal, did agree to sell to Matthias Benzinger, all those several tracts or parcels of land described in the warrants hereinafter mentioned, situate formerly in the counties of M'Kean and Clearfield, and now in the county of Elk, in the state of Pennsylvania. to wit:—Warrant No. four thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (4885); four thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (4886); four thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (4887); four thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight (4888); four thousand nine hundred and seventy-four (4974); four thousand nine hundred and seventy-five (4975); four thousand nine hundred and seventy-six (4976); four thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven (4977); four thousand nine hundred and ninety (4990); four thousand nine hundred and ninety-one (4991); four thousand nine hundred and ninety-two (4992); and four thousand nine hundred and ninety-three (4993); making in all about twelve thousand and fourteen acres, and the usual allowance of six per cent. for roads, for the price or sum of nine thousand dollars; and to execute a deed of conveyance, in fee simple, with a clear title for the same, to the said Matthias Benzinger, as in the said agreement is more fully set forth:
