AN ACT

Relative to tax collectors in Montgomery county; to registered taxes within the county of Philadelphia; the collection of mercantile taxes, and Wyalusing election district, Bradford county.

Relative to tax
collectors in
Montgomery co.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the fourth section of the act, approved the twenty-sixth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, entitled "An Act providing that the treasurers of Lycoming and Schuylkill counties, shall receive a fixed salary, and regulating fees in certain cases, and for other purposes," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Suits for register-
ed taxes in Phila-
delphia county.

That suits for all registered taxes within the county of Philadelphia, may be brought in the name of the county, and the prothonotary and sheriff shall not be entitled to any compensation from the said county, for process in such suits: *Provided,* That where the costs are recovered, the same shall be paid to the officers as in other cases.

Proviso.

Costs for collect-
ing mercantile
taxes to be paid
out of state trea-
sury.

And so much of any law as requires the payment from county treasuries, of the costs of collecting mercantile taxes, be and the same is hereby repealed; and such costs shall be paid out of the state treasury, on the warrants of the auditor general.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the electors of the township of Wyalusing, Bradford county, shall hereafter hold their general elections at the house of John H. Black, in said township.
