A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Liberty fire company of Holmesburg, in the county of Philadelphia," approved the twenty-sixth day of July, eighteen hundred and forty-two, and to authorize the commissioners of Penn district, to change the lines of Girard avenue to meet Franklin avenue.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall and may be lawful hereafter to carry by certificate, judgments rendered in the court of nisi prius, for the city and county of Philadelphia, to the supreme court for review, notwithstanding that the party obtaining such certificate shall not have given absolute security, with two sufficient sureties, by recognizance, for the payment of all damages and costs, in case the proceedings shall be affirmed; and notwithstanding that such party shall not carry the said judgment to the supreme court for hearing, at the next term thereof; and such certificate shall be a supersedeas of execution, issued out and executed in those cases, and in those only where the certificate shall have been required and obtained, and security entered, within three weeks from the day on which judgment shall have been rendered: *Provided always,* That the said certificate be required and obtained, within seven years after the judgment shall be rendered against the party requiring and obtaining the said certificate, unless the party entitled to the said certificate shall, at the time such title accrued, be within the age of twenty-one years, covert, non compos mentis, in prison, or out of the limits of the United States of America, in which case such person, his or her heirs, executors or administrators, (notwithstanding the said seven years be expired) shall and may carry such judgment, by certificate, to the supreme court for review, so as the same be done within five years after his or her full age, discovery, coming to sound mind, enlargement, out of prison or return into some one of the United States of America, but not afterwards nor otherwise: *And provided also,* That the same tax shall be paid to the commonwealth, in those cases as are now paid in cases of removals on writs of error.

SECTION 2. That the commissioners of Penn district, county of Philadelphia, be and are hereby authorized and empowered to change the lines of Girard avenue to meet Franklin avenue, in said district.
