A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act incorporating the House of Refuge, passed the twenty-third of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-six.

Appropriation out of the county funds of Philadelphia, to house of refuge.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* when buildings for a house of refuge, for colored juvenile delinquents, shall be erected and opened for the reception of inmates in the county of Philadelphia, the commissioners of the county of Philadelphia be and they are hereby authorized to draw their warrants on the treasurer of said county, in favor of the treasurer of the house of refuge, for four thousand dollars per annum, for five years, in addition to the sum now authorized by law ; the payment of the aforesaid additional sum to commence on the first Monday of the month following an official notice to be given by the managers of the house of refuge, to the commissioners of the county of Philadelphia, that the aforementioned buildings are ready for the admission of inmates ; and the same be continued annually on the first Monday of the same month, for the term of five years, and shall be applied by the said managers, exclusively, for the purposes of the institution.
