AN ACT

Supplementary to the act to incorporate the Trenton City bridge company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so soon as the dividends upon the capital stock of the Trenton bridge, shall have been sufficient to reimburse the stockholders the amount of the cost of said bridge, and the interest thereon, a majority of said stockholders may, at a meeting convened for that purpose, of which three weeks' notice shall be given in at least two of the newspapers published in the county of Bucks, and two in the city of Trenton, declare the said bridge to be free for the passage of all foot passengers and vehicles of every description, without the exaction of any tolls whatever therefor: *Provided,* The said city, by the common councils thereof, will agree to keep the same in repair; and so long as the same is thus kept in repair, it shall remain free as aforesaid. When to be declared a free bridge.

SECTION 2. It shall be lawful for the president and directors of said company, to locate said bridge at such place as they may deem most suitable, being at and opposite the city of Trenton, on the river Delaware. Location.

SECTION 3. This act shall not go into effect, until a like supplement shall be passed by the legislature of New Jersey. Assent of New Jersey necessary.

AN ACT,

Authorizing the burgess, assistant burgess and town council of the borough of Marietta, in Lancaster county, to provide a lock-up house.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the burgess, assistant burgess and town council of the borough of Marietta, in Lancaster county, be and they are hereby authorized to erect a lock-up house.
