AN ACT

To authorize the commissioners of Blair county to borrow money.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the county of Blair be and they are hereby authorized to borrow a sum of money for county purposes, not exceeding five thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent., and for a period not exceeding three years.

AN ACT

Authorizing the commissioners of M'Kean county to appropriate, out of the county funds, three thousand dollars for road purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of M'Kean county be and they are hereby authorized to appropriate, out of the county funds, three thousand dollars to repair the road leading from Mill Grove to Coudersport, and that the said commissioners are hereby authorized to appoint three competent persons, whose duty it shall be to expend such money in repairing and improving such part of said road as lies in said county of M'Kean, who shall give bonds for the faithful expenditure of such money, which said bonds shall be approved by the court of quarter sessions, and shall on or before the first day of January in each year, settle their accounts with the auditors of M'Kean county, in such manner as the accounts of other county officers are now settled, until the whole sum so appropriated shall have been expended.

SECTION 2. That the aforesaid commissioners are authorized to make the further appropriation of two thousand dollars, to be laid out in

a judicious manner, for the purpose of repairing that part of the mail road from Smethport to Lock Haven, which lies between Norwich Four Corners, in Norwich township, and the mouth of North creek, in Shippen township, the same to be appropriated and expended, according to the provisions of the first section of this act.

AN ACT

Declaring the West Branch of Pine creek, in the county of Potter, a public highway, and relative to certain depositions in Mifflin county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the West Branch of Pine creek, in the county of Potter, is hereby declared a public highway the distance of eight miles from its mouth up the said West Branch.

WHEREAS, An act of assembly passed the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, authorizing the court of common pleas of Mifflin county to receive, in evidence, certain depositions taken on short notice : *And whereas,* A mistake occurred in the name of the plaintiff mentioned in said law ; therefore, *Be it enacted,* That the words in said law as follows :—"In the case of the Bank of Missouri against James Alexander," inserted in brackets, be and they are hereby stricken out of said law.
