Relating to the election of county treasurer in the county of M'Kean.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the electors of the county of M'Kean, at the general election in October, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, shall elect one person as county treasurer, to serve for one year; and at the regular annual general election thereafter, shall elect one person as county treasurer, to serve for two years as heretofore.*

A N A C T

Authorizing the canal commissioners to investigate the claims of Dennis Brawley, junior.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the canal commissioners of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to investigate the claims of Dennis Brawley, junior, for damages done to him on the Allegheny Portage railroad, and on the Columbia railroad, and to allow him such damages as they think he shall be entitled to in equity and justice, and make report thereof to the next legislature.*
