Authorizing the administrator of William Witman to make a deed for certain real estate.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, William Witman, late of the borough of Reading, and county of Berks, deceased, in his lifetime was the president of the Farmers' Bank of Reading, and the said bank obtained a judgment against John Heater, and had executions issued on the same, by virtue of which the sheriff of Schuylkill county sold a certain tract of land, situate in West Penn township, Schuylkill county, and state of Pennsylvania, bounded by lands of Lewis Shrack, Samuel Kepner and others, containing fifty-seven acres, more or less, to the said William Witman, as president of said bank and for the bank, but the sheriff's deed was made to said William Witman, in his own name, and the said William Witman died without conveying the said tract of land to the bank; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall and may be lawful for Charles Witman, administrator of William Witman, deceased, late of the borough of Reading, to execute, acknowledge and deliver to the Farmers' Bank of Reading, a deed, conveying a tract of land, situate in West Penn township, Schuylkill county, bounded by lands now or late of Lewis Shrack, Samuel Kepner and others, containing fifty-seven acres, more or less: *Provided,* That the costs and charges shall be paid by the said bank.
