AN ACT

To provide for the construction of a weigh lock on the North Branch division of the Pennsylvania canal.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners are hereby authorized to construct a weigh lock on the North Branch division of the Pennsylvania canal, at such place as they shall deem most expedient and conducive to the public interest: *Provided,* The expense for constructing the same shall not exceed eight thousand dollars; and the sum of eight thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for that purpose.

AN ACT

For the relief of William Guthrie, of Mercer county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the auditor general be and is hereby directed to examine and settle the claim of William Guthrie, of Mercer county, for a balance due him on an estimate on Shenango line, Erie extension, Pennsylvania canal, and should any balance be found due said claimant, he is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the amount, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
