AN ACT

For the relief of certain soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to John Brewer, James Collins and Jacob Whollery, of Fayette county; Adam Brookhouser, of Crawford county; Ephraim Fry and Charlotte Miller, of Franklin county, Pennsylvania, and Jacob Laumon, of Montgomery county, Maryland, soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars, or to their respective orders, an annuity of forty dollars per annum each, during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven; and to Michael Dill, of Allegheny county, and Nathaniel Price, of Bucks county, each a gratuity of forty dollars.

SECTION 2. That so much of the second section of an act, entitled "An Act for the relief of certain soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars," approved the twenty-first of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, as relates to Samuel Dean, James M'Donald and Henry Semans, shall be understood as applying to persons of those names in Fayette county.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to authorize the voters of Mifflin county to decide the question of tavern license therein, and to prohibit the sale of intoxicating drinks within specified limits in certain counties.
