## A SUPPLEMENT

To an act for the incorporation of the Pittsburg, Kittanning and Warren railroad company, passed April fourth, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the time for commencing the construction of the Pittsburg, Kittanning and Warren railroad shall be and is hereby extended until the first day of June, eighteen hundred and fifty-two; and that the said company are hereby authorized to extend the said road from Warren to the New York state line. Time for commencing, extended.

SECTION 2. That the time for the completion of the said railroad be and is hereby extended to the first day of June, eighteen hundred and sixty-two, any thing in the act to which this is a supplement, to the contrary notwithstanding. Completion.

## AN ACT

To renew the warrants of John H. Wolf, for the collection of outstanding tax in Canton township, in Washington county.
