A N A C T

To annul the marriage contract of Elizabeth Kuhns and Samuel Kuhns.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between Elizabeth Kuhns and Samuel Kuhns, of the county of Somerset, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from said contract, and from all the duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely, as if they had never been joined in marriage.*

A S U P P L E M E N T

To an act to authorize the governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company for the purpose of making and erecting a bridge and road over the North-east Branch of the Susquehanna, in the county of Northumberland, from the public highway opposite the plantation of Thomas Grant, to Shamokin island, through the public highway of Shamokin island, to the shore opposite Northumberland, and from thence to the town of Northumberland, passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and nine, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the commissioners of the county of Northumberland, or a majority of them, be and are hereby authorized to subscribe, on behalf of said county, one hundred and twenty shares (being three thousand dollars) in the new stock lately created by the Northumberland bridge company, in pursuance of an act of assembly, passed the twenty-eighth day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.*
