AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Jesse Benners and Harriet, his wife, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between Jesse Benners, of the county of Lehigh, and Harriet, his wife, be and the same is hereby declared null and void, and the parties discharged from all the obligations and liabilities growing out of the same, as fully and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.*

SECTION 2. That the provisions contained in the act, entitled "An Act to annul the marriage contract of Anna Maria Kraft and Lewis Kraft," passed the eighteenth day of April, A. D. eighteen hundred and forty-three, which declares that the word "citizen," as used in the eleventh section of the act concerning divorces, passed the thirteenth of March, A. D. eighteen hundred and fifteen, shall not be construed to apply to any woman who shall have a bona fide residence in this state at least one whole year previous to filing said petition or libel, be and the same is hereby repealed.
