AN ACT

To extend the charter of the Farmers' Bank of Reading.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the charter of the Farmers' Bank of Reading shall be and the same is hereby extended and continued for the term of ten years from the expiration of the present charter, subject to the provisions now imposed upon banks by the existing laws of this commonwealth, and all and singular the same provisions and restrictions as are imposed on the Western Bank of Philadelphia, by the act, entitled "An Act to extend the charter of the Western Bank of Philadelphia," approved the seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six; and the stockholders of the said Farmers' Bank of Reading shall be subject to the same liabilities and remedies as the stockholders of the said Western Bank of Philadelphia are made liable to by the provisions of the said act. Charter extended for ten years.
