AN ACT

Providing for extraordinary repairs on the public works.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sum of fifty thousand dollars be and the same is hereby specifically appropriated for extraordinary repairs on the canals and railroads of the commonwealth, during the present fiscal year.* Appropriation.
