AN ACT

Regulating election districts.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* hereafter the qualified voters in South Mahoning township, in the county Indiana. of Indiana, shall hold their township and general elections at the house now occupied by James Hays, in the village of Plumville, in said township.

SECTION 2. That hereafter the qualified voters of Canoe township, in Indiana county, shall hold their township and general elections at the house now occupied by George Smith, in said township ; and that John Miller, of said township, is hereby appointed judge, and John Pollock and James Gallaher, are hereby appointed inspectors, who will hold and conduct the township election, for said township of Canoe, in February next, for the election of the usual township officers for the ensuing year; that the said judge and inspectors shall, in holding and conducting said township election, have the same authority, in like manner, as is required, and prescribed, and directed in the act relating to the elections of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, passed the second day of July, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

SECTION 3. That the qualified voters of Montgomery township, Indiana county, shall hereafter hold their general and spring elections at the house now occupied by Samuel Spaker, in said township ; and that Jeremiah M'Allister, of said township, be and he is hereby appointed judge, and Samuel Irwin and James R. Gailey be and they are hereby appointed inspectors of said spring elections.

SECTION 4. That hereafter the qualified voters of Bloomsburg township, in the county of Columbia, shall hold their general elections in the court house in the town of Bloomsburg.

SECTION 5. That hereafter the qualified voters of East Finley township, county of Washington, shall hold their township and general elections at the house of Joseph Martin, on the farm of William Brown Lee.
