SUPPLEMENT

To the act to incorporate the Wiconisco canal company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the period for the completion of the Wiconisco canal be and the same is hereby extended for the term of two years from the thirteenth March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, subject to all the reservations, restrictions, provisions and penalties contained in the act of incorporation to which this is a supplement.
