A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act relating to premiums on wolf scalps, in the counties of Monroe, Pike, Potter and Westmoreland," passed the fifteenth March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, and relating to wild cat and fox scalps, in Elk and Mifflin counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the provisions of the act, entitled "An Act relating to premiums on wolf scalps, in the counties of Monroe, Pike, Potter and Westmoreland," passed March fifteenth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, be and are hereby extended to the county of M'Kean. Extended to the county of

SECTION 2. That from and after the passage of this act, the bounty on wild cat and fox scalps of all kinds, in the county of Elk, shall be fifty cents for each and every scalp, to be paid out of the county funds in the treasury of said county, by order of the commissioners, after due proof being made by the oath of the person killing the same, together with scalps, taken before a justice of the peace, in said county.

SECTION 3. That from and after the passage of this act, the bounty on old fox scalps shall be one dollar, and for young fox scalps fifty cents, in the county of Mifflin. On fox scalps in Mifflin county.
