Authorizing the payment to Mrs. Jane Shunk, widow of Francis R. Shunk, deceased, of a certain balance of the annual salary of the late executive.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be and is hereby authorized to pay to Mrs. Jane Shunk, the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty-seven dollars, being the balance of the annual salary of the late executive, Francis R. A N A C T

Relative to the claim of J. W. Hammond.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the petition of J. W. Hammond, and the documents accompanying it, relative to a claim for services rendered under the twenty-second section of the act of twenty-eighth April, one thousand eight hundred and forty, are hereby referred to the auditor general and state treasurer, who are authorized to examine and settle the said claim in the usual manner: *Provided however,* That they shall first be fully satisfied that any balance is legally due to the said Hammond, and that the same shall not exceed the sum of six hundred and fifteen dollars and
