A SUPPLEMENT

To an act authorizing the sale of real estate in Luzerne and Columbia counties, and for other purposes, passed the tenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight.

WHEREAS, By the second section of the said act, the commissioners therein named are directed to apply the proceeds of the sale of the court house, and other public buildings and real estate on which they are erected, or is appurtenant thereto, situate in the town of Danville, in Columbia county, as directed by the act, entitled "An Act concerning the removal of the seat of justice of the county of Columbia, from Danville to Bloomsburg," passed the twenty-fourth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five: Preamble.

And whereas, By the second section of the last mentioned act, it is directed that so much of the proceeds of said sale as is necessary to refund to the citizens of Danville, whatever amount of money they may have given for the original construction of the public buildings at said town, and the purchase of the lots of ground on which they are erected, shall be refunded to said citizens; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the said commissioners be hereby authorized and directed to give one month's notice in the two newspapers published in Danville, to all persons interested, of the time and place of meeting of the said commissioners, for the purpose of distributing the proceeds of said sale; which distribution is to be final and conclusive; and to distribute the proceeds of the said sale, after deducting the necessary costs and expenses incident to the said sale and distribution, pro rata, to and among all individual contributors, their executors and administrators, whether they reside, in Danville or elsewhere. Commissioners to give notice of distribution, &c.
