AN ACT

To provide for the payment of certain laborers on the public works, and for repairs on the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the sum of seventy thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to the payment of debts due by the commonwealth to laborers, for the payment for work heretofore done and performed by them, and for materials of certain debts, heretofore furnished, and for repairs to be done between this and the first day of June next, for and on the public improvements of this commonwealth; the said sum to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated. Appropriation

SECTION 2. That if any portion of the sum so set apart by the first section of this act, shall remain in the treasury after the said first day of June next, all payments out of such fund shall cease; the said sum so remaining, shall be used and applied as other money then in the treasury.

SECTION 3. That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to borrow, on temporary loan, the sum of seventy thousand dollars, if so much be required, to be applied as provided for in the first section of this act; the said loan to be re-imbursable in ninety days from the passage of this act, and to be negotiated on the terms, and secured in the same manner, as the loan authorized by an act, entitled "An Act to authorize the state treasurer to borrow money on temporary loan," passed the twenty-ninth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine. State treasurer authorized to borrow on temporary loan.
