A N A C T

Authorizing the commissioners of Schuylkill county to sell certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the commissioners of Schuylkill county are hereby authorized to sell, either at public or private sale, for the best price that can be reasonably had therefor, all that certain house and lot of ground situate in the borough of Schuylkill Haven, in the county of Schuylkill, being the same premises which was sold by the sheriff of said county of Schuylkill, as the property of Roland Kline, and purchased by the commissioners for a debt due to the said county; and having sold, to convey the same to the purchaser or purchasers in fee simple.*
