A N A C T

To extend the limits of the borough of Brookville.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the limits of the borough of Brookville, in Jefferson county, are so extended as to include the whole of the survey in name of Timothy Pickering and company, number three hundred and ninety-four, being the same survey within which the borough of Brookville is located; and the jurisdiction of the officers and school directors of said borough, are hereby extended to the outer lines of said survey.
