AN ACT

Relating to assessors in the counties of Berks and Luzerne.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the fifty-ninth section of an act regulating election districts, and for other purposes, approved the eleventh day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as the same relates to Berks and Luzerne counties.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Buckingham and Doylestown turnpike road company," passed thirtieth April, eighteen hundred and forty-three.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That when, and so often as the president and managers of the Buckingham and Doylestown turnpike road company, shall have completed one mile of road, that they may proceed to have the same inspected and licensed for taking toll thereon, in the same manner, and with like restrictions and privileges, as is provided in the tenth section of the act incorporating the Danborough and Doylestown turnpike road company.

SECTION 2. That the said president, and managers and company, shall be and they are hereby authorized to borrow for the purposes of the company, any sum not exceeding five thousand dollars; and for the purpose of securing the payment of the same to the lender or lenders, may issue certificates of loan, in sums of not less than one hundred dollars each, to be signed by the said president and treasurer, and sealed with the seal of the corporation, to be payable at such time, and upon
