

paper published in Philadelphia, and a copy of this act be transmitted, by mail or otherwise, to each of said holders of loan or claim, as far as they can be ascertained : *And provided also*, That all or any dissenting parties, under this act, shall have power to perpetuate proof of such dissent, by the means now allowed by law for perpetuating testimony in other cases.

Rights of non-assenting holders secured.

SECTION 13. That nothing contained in this act shall be so construed as to injure or in any way invalidate the rights of non-assenting loan-holders.

AN ACT

To authorize the president, managers and company of the Schuylkill Valley navigation and railroad company, to increase their capital stock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That it shall be lawful for the president, managers and company of the Schuylkill Valley navigation and railroad company, to increase their capital stock from time to time, as they may deem expedient : *Provided*, That not more than three thousand shares in the whole of additional stock, shall be created under the provisions of this act : *And provided further*, That no additional stock shall be created under the provisions of this act, unless the said company shall, at an annual, general or other lawful meeting, have authorized the issue thereof ; nor shall a certificate for any share of such additional stock be issued, until the sum of fifty dollars for the same shall have been actually paid in to the treasurer of said company, in such instalments as shall have been directed by the president and managers thereof.
