A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act relating to roads, highways and bridges, in the counties of Warren, Venango, M'Kean, and for other purposes," approved April ninth, eighteen hundred and forty-four.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the fourth section of the act, passed the ninth day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, to which this is a supplement, as requires the commissioners to lay such tax upon the property so assessed as they shall deem necessary, for road and bridge purposes for the current year, not exceeding five mills on the dollar on the valuation so made, shall be so altered and amended as to authorize said commissioners, in the borough of Warren, and several townships in the county of Warren, to lay such tax upon the property so assessed as they shall deem necessary, for road and bridge purposes for the current year, not exceeding ten mills on every dollar of valuation so made: *Provided, If a less sum than ten mills should be levied, and the same should be insufficient to repair the roads and bridges, or keep the same in good order and repair, then an additional sum, not exceeding in all ten mills on every dollar of valuation so made as aforesaid, may be raised by said commissioners for that purpose.* Rates of taxation in Warren county increased for road and bridge purposes.

SECTION 2. That the bridge across the Brokenstraw creek, at Irvine, in the township of Brokenstraw, and county of Warren, having been built and heretofore repaired at the expense of said county, be and the same is hereby declared a county bridge; and the county commissioners shall, from and after the passage of this act, take charge of, repair and rebuild said bridge when necessary. County commissioners to repair bridge over Brokenstraw creek.
