A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to amend the road laws of Erie county, and for other purposes," passed the twenty-seventh day of March, eighteen hundred and forty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the road commissioners of Fairview township, Erie county, shall have power to collect any sum not exceeding thirty-five per cent. in money, on the road tax so laid by them; the said money to be collected in the way and manner prescribed by the second section of the act to which this is a supplement. Road commissioners of Fairview township, Erie county, to collect certain road tax.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this act are such that it shall only remain in force up to the first day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-eight. Duration of this act.

AN ACT

To authorize the county commissioners of Armstrong and Clarion counties, to build and keep in repair a bridge over Red Bank creek.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the county commissioners of the counties of Armstrong and Clarion, shall have power to build, erect and keep in repair, at the joint and equal expense of the said Armstrong and Clarion counties, a bridge over Red Bank creek, at or near Yost Smith's ferry. Commissioners to erect bridge over Red Bank creek.

SECTION 2. That so much of the laws of this commonwealth as exempt the county of Armstrong, from being at any expense in building Repeal of act, so far as exempts Armstrong county.
