

being shown to the satisfaction of the said court, it shall be lawful for the said court to decree and order that the said indenture shall be cancelled and annulled, either absolutely or upon such terms as the court shall see fit; and the same shall thereupon be cancelled and annulled accordingly, and the said orphan child, and the corporation aforesaid, and all other persons be respectively discharged therefrom.

AN ACT

Supplementary to an act, entitled "An Act in relation to the duties of county auditors in the county of Potter, and for other purposes," approved April seventeenth, eighteen hundred and forty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* it shall and may be lawful for John M'Ewen, Allen N. Work, John Ewing and Cornelius Lloyd, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to audit and settle all the unsettled business of Mahoning township, Indiana county, (except the accounts of old supervisors of the highways in said township,) and to demand, sue for and collect all debts due said township, of any description whatever, and to divide the money so collected among the different townships that have been erected out of said Mahoning township, and apportion the just claims of individuals against said township, in the same way among the said new erected townships, in proportion to the number of their taxable inhabitants.
