A N A C T

To change the name of the York Savings Bank to that of the York County Bank.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the corporate name and style of the York Savings Bank shall be hereafter the York County Bank, by which latter name said institution shall continue to be invested with all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the liabilities and restrictions it was invested with, and subject to, under its former name.

SECTION 2. In all cases where judgments have been obtained by, or bonds, notes or engagements made to said bank by its former name, it shall be lawful to enforce and collect the same in the name of the York Savings Bank, for the use of the York County Bank.
