A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to authorize the governor to incorporate the Delaware County turnpike road company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Delaware County turnpike road company be and they are hereby authorized to lay one or more tracks of plank upon any part of their road, and to convert such part thereof into a plank road; and in case a sufficient amount of stock should not be subscribed to enable the managers of said company to complete and finish such part of said road as it shall be determined to lay with plank as aforesaid, they shall be authorized to borrow, on the credit of the company, a sufficient sum of money to complete the same: *Provided*, That the amount so borrowed shall not exceed three thousand dollars: *And provided further*, That the persons loaning said money, their heirs or assigns, may at any time convert their loan into stock of said company. Delaware County turnpike road company authorized to lay one or more tracks of plank roads, &c.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of the seventh, eighth and tenth sections of the general act regulating turnpike and plank road companies, passed the twenty-sixth day of January, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and the third and fourth sections of the supplement thereto, passed the seventh day of April of the same year, be and the same are hereby extended to the Delaware County turnpike road company: *Provided*, That the president and managers of said company shall have the same authority in the regulation of the tolls of said road, as is given to stockholders by the provisions of the fourth section of said supplement. Provisions of certain act extended to said company.

SECTION 3. That in the construction of the remaining portion of said road westward, the said company shall not be compelled to construct the artificial parts thereof of a greater width than eighteen feet, and in case the court of quarter sessions of the county of Delaware shall not be in session at the time of the completion of the same, it shall be competent for the associate judges of said county to appoint persons to view the said road as is provided by the tenth section of the act of incorporation of said company.
