## AN ACT

Erecting an independent school district out of parts of Westmoreland and Fayette counties, to be called Bridgeport.

Boundaries.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all those parts of the counties of Westmoreland and Fayette, included within the following boundaries, to wit: Commencing where the state road leading from Mount Pleasant to Smith's mill, crosses Neel's run; thence by the line of the land of John Zundiel to the line of the land of Michael Troxal; thence by the line of the land of said Troxal to Jacob's creek, said creek being the county line between Westmoreland and Fayette counties; thence crossing Jacob's creek and taking the line of the land of John B. Troxal, in Bullsken township, in the county of Fayette, including the farm of J. B. Troxal, to the line of the land of A. Pershing; thence by the line of the land of said Pershing to Jacob's creek; thence crossing Jacob's creek to the Westmoreland side, in Mount Pleasant township, by the line of the land of the heirs of Isaac Shupe, including said farm, bordering on Jacob's creek, in Mount Pleasant township, to the line of the land of Haylett Miller; thence by the line of the land of said Miller to the line of the land of captain Alexander Miller; thence by the line of the land of said Alexander Miller to the line of the land of the Rev. Mr. Fulton; thence by the line of the land of the said Fulton to the Connellsville road; thence along said road in the direction of Mount Pleasant, to the corner of the lot of Uriah S. Johnston, including said lot; thence by the line of said lot to the line of the land of John Zundiel; thence by said line to the place of beginning, be and the same is hereby erected into a separate and independent school district, to be called Bridgeport, with full power to elect school directors, to collect the school tax assessed for the year eighteen hundred and forty-nine on the property within said district, and conforming in all respects to the school laws of this commonwealth.
