A N A C T

Forming the borough of Saegertown, in the county of Crawford, into a separate election district; and for changing the place of holding elections in certain election districts; and relative to a town-house in East Fallowfield township, in Crawford county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the borough of Saegertown, in the county of Crawford, shall hereafter form a separate school and election district, and the qualified electors thereof shall hold their general, special and borough elections at the frame school house in said borough; the first election for borough officers for said borough, shall be held on the fifteenth day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and that Isaac Saeger shall act as judge, and John M'Closkey and Charles Hecker as inspectors of said election, who are hereby required to give ten days' notice of said election, in five or more handbills placed in the most public places in said borough.

Borough of Saegertown erected into a separate school and election district.

SECTION 2. That the qualified electors of the township of Woodcock, in the county of Crawford, shall hereafter hold their general and township elections at the town-house in said township.

Elections in Woodcock township, Crawford county.

SECTION 3. That the road commissioners of East Fallowfield township, Crawford county, are hereby authorized and directed to levy and collect a township tax, in East Fallowfield township, for the purpose of purchasing a lot of ground, not exceeding one-half acre, and erecting thereupon a suitable town-house for all township purposes; the said commissioners shall levy the aforesaid tax upon all real and personal property that is now taxable for county and road purposes, and shall levy and collect the same in money, at the time and manner, and by the same authority that the school tax is now levied and collected: *Provided,* That the aforesaid tax shall be collected and kept in a separate fund for the above-mentioned purposes; and that the aforesaid town-house shall be finished for election and township purposes on or before the second Tuesday of October, one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

Commissioners of East Fallowfield township, Crawford county, authorized to levy and collect tax, &c.

Proviso.

SECTION 4. That John Henry, James S. Shellito and Robert M'Entire are hereby constituted a building committee, with full authority to purchase the aforesaid piece or parcel of ground, not exceeding one-half acre, and construct and build the aforesaid town-house thereupon, in such manner as they may deem expedient and proper. The deed for the aforesaid piece or parcel of ground, shall be taken in the name of the township auditors and their successors, for the use of said township forever. The road commissioners shall pay, or cause to be paid over to the building committee, all moneys collected for the aforesaid purposes, within ten days after the said money is collected: And further, it shall be the duty of the township auditors to examine and settle the accounts of the building committee, upon the completion of the aforesaid town-house, and report upon the same, in the same manner that they now settle with the road commissioners and path-masters: *Provided,*

Building committee.

Deed for property to be taken in the name of the township auditors.

Duties of township auditors.

Proviso.

That the building committee shall purchase the aforesaid lot of ground at or as near the centre of the aforesaid township as practicable, and that the whole expense of the ground and house shall not exceed two hundred and twenty-five dollars; and that the township and general elections hereafter shall be held at the aforesaid town-house, in the township of East Fallowfield, Crawford county.

Union township, SECTION 5. That the qualified electors of Union township, in the
Schuylkill county, of Schuylkill, shall hereafter hold their township and general elections at the house of Daniel Goho, in said township.

North East ward, SECTION 6. That the qualified voters of the North-East ward of the
Pottsville, borough of Pottsville, in the county of Schuylkill, shall hereafter hold
Schuylkill their general and ward elections at the house of Patrick Curry, in said
county. ward.

Repeal of certain SECTION 7. That the act, entitled "An Act relating to roads and
act so far as re- bridges in the counties of Crawford, Clearfield and Greene," approved
lates to Vernon the seventh day of May, one thousand eight hundred and forty-four,
township, Craw- and all supplements thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed, so
ford county. far as it relates to the township of Vernon, in the county of Crawford.

South Butler township, SECTION 8. The qualified voters of South Butler township, Butler
county, elections in. county, shall hereafter hold their general and township elections at the
house now occupied by Martin Laurent, senior, in said township.

AN ACT

To authorize John Beitler and Ezekiel Evans to sell a lot of ground in Uwchlan township, Chester county, for school purposes; and relating to the borough of Canonsburg, Washington county.

Preamble. WHEREAS, A certain Joseph Phipps and Mary, his wife, by their deed of indenture bearing date the fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and thirty-six, and recorded at West Chester, in deed book P, volume 15, page 135, granted and conveyed a certain piece or lot of land situate in the township of Uwchlan, in the county of Chester, containing about one acre of land, unto Samuel John, Charles Gallive and John Vaughan, in trust for the use and benefit of the inhabitants of the said township of Uwchlan, for a school house and the purposes of a school:

And whereas, No school house has ever been erected on said lot or piece of ground, owing to its unfitness for that purpose, and the same is
