AN ACT

To authorize John Beitler and Ezekiel Evans to sell a lot of ground in Uwchlan township, Chester county, for school purposes; and relating to the borough of Canonsburg, Washington county.

Preamble. WHEREAS, A certain Joseph Phipps and Mary, his wife, by their deed of indenture bearing date the fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and thirty-six, and recorded at West Chester, in deed book P, volume 15, page 135, granted and conveyed a certain piece or lot of land situate in the township of Uwchlan, in the county of Chester, containing about one acre of land, unto Samuel John, Charles Gallive and John Vaughan, in trust for the use and benefit of the inhabitants of the said township of Uwchlan, for a school house and the purposes of a school:

And whereas, No school house has ever been erected on said lot or piece of ground, owing to its unfitness for that purpose, and the same is

therefore useless to the citizens of the township for the purposes designated in said deed :

And whereas, It is desirable that the said lot or piece of ground should be sold, and the proceeds thereof be paid over to the board of directors of the public school of said township of Uwchlan, to be applied to general school purposes in said township, and the trustees aforesaid all being dead; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That John Beitler and Ezekiel Evans, of the township of Uwchlan aforesaid, be and they are hereby authorized to sell at public sale, after having given sufficient notice of the same, the above lot or piece of land bounded and described as follows: beginning at a white oak marked in the land of Jonathan Phipps; and from thence west forty-five degrees south eight perches to a stake in or near the main road of the said township, (known as the Warwick road,) from thence south forty-five degrees east twenty perches to a stake; thence east forty-five degrees north eight perches to a chestnut; thence north forty-five degrees west twenty perches to the place of beginning, containing by estimation one acre of land be it more or less, and pay over the proceeds of the sale of the said lot or piece of ground to the board of directors of public school in said township of Uwchlan, to be by the said board applied to the general uses of the public school of the said township.

That from and after the passage of this act, the burgess and town council of the borough of Cannonsburg, county of Washington, are hereby authorized and empowered to make a deed conveying the title to James M'Ewen, for a certain alley in said borough, joining lands of said James M'Ewen, and others.
