AN ACT

To authorize the Jenkinstown lyceum company to borrow money.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Jenkinstown lyceum, located in the county of Montgomery, is hereby authorized to borrow any sum or sums of money, not exceeding five hundred dollars, to liquidate the debt on said institution, and to mortgage the corporate property to secure the payment of the same.
