

of burial lots; to appoint all necessary officers, and fix their several duties and compensations; and to make such by-laws, rules and regulations as they may deem proper for conducting the affairs of the corporation; for the government of lot holders and visitors to the cemetery; and for the transfer of lots, and the evidence thereof.

SECTION 3. That every lot conveyed in such cemetery, shall be held by the proprietor for the purpose of sepulture alone; transferable with consent of the trustees in trust, and their successors in office, as aforesaid, and shall not be subject to attachment or execution; and that the said cemetery shall hereafter be forever exempted from taxation: *Provided*, That said exemption from attachment or execution shall not extend to more than four lots held by any one individual.

AN ACT

To extend the time for completing the Butler and Freeport turnpike road.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the time for the completion of the Butler and Freeport turnpike road, is hereby extended for a period of five years, to be computed from the twenty-second day of February, one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
