AN ACT

For the purpose of correcting a clerical error in the twenty-second section of the act, entitled "An Act to provide for the ordinary expenses of government, for the repairs of the canals and railroads of the commonwealth, and the payment of other claims due the same," passed the tenth April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

WHEREAS, An error has occurred in transcribing the twenty-second section of the appropriation act of the tenth of April last, the name of William Keeler being written as William Reber, and the name of Moses J. Clark being written as Moses Y. Clark; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* where the name of William Reber occurs in the twenty second section of the appropriation act of the tenth April last, it shall be read William Keeler, and where the name of Moses Y. Clark occurs, it shall be read as Moses J. Clark, so that under said act the money therein mentioned shall be payable to Henry W. Tracy, as attorney in fact of William Keeler.

AN ACT

Authorizing William M. M'Cormick to pay an annuity charged upon his land.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the treasurer of the Great Island church, in the county of Clinton, be authorized and empowered to receive from William M. M'Cormick, or those claiming under him, the sum of five hundred dollars, to be placed at interest, and the same annually applied to the payment of the pas-
