That the treasurer of the said congregation shall give bond, with good and sufficient sureties, in such sum as the trustees thereof shall direct and approve, for the faithful performance of the duties of his office; and the loans of the said sum shall be secured by bond and mortgage on sufficient real estate. A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to authorize the governor of this state to incorporate a company to construct a bridge over the river Delaware, and near the town of Milford, in the county of Wayne, Pennsylvania," passed the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and fourteen.

WHEREAS, The bridge erected by the company incorporated by the acts to which this is a supplement, was carried away by a freshet and Preamble. entirely lost :

And whereas, The said company have since that time collected all their assets, and being unable to re-build said bridge, have made a distribution to and among the stockholders:

And whereas, The stock of said bridge is so much scattered, and some of the stockholders cannot be consulted, and others of them are incapable of acting, and it is desirable that said bridge should be again erected; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the said president, managers and company be and they are hereby authorized to issue new stock, to an amount sufficient to re-build said bridge: *Provided,* That in re-building said bridge, it shall be so constructed as not to interfere with or impede the navigation of the river.

SECTION 2. That when said new stock shall be subscribed, and such parts of it be paid as may be agreed upon and be necessary, the said new stockholders shall be deemed to be the only stockholders of said bridge: *Provided:* That said president, managers and company shall give public notice of the time when, and places where they will receive

subscriptions for the said new stock: *And provided also*, That the present stockholders, or any of them, shall have a right to subscribe for the amount of stock now held by them, if they desire so to do, in preference to any other persons: *And provided also*, That the assent of the state of New Jersey to this supplement be first obtained.

Relative to the safe keeping of prisoners in the county of Mifflin.

WHEREAS, The present jail in the county of Mifflin is insufficient for the safe keeping of prisoners; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the sheriff of Mifflin county is hereby authorized, if he shall deem it necessary for the safe keeping of prisoners, to lodge them in the jail of Dauphin county, the jailor whereof is hereby directed to receive such prisoners into his custody, and there to keep until demanded by the sheriff of Mifflin county; and all expenses so incurred shall be paid by an order drawn by the commissioners of Mifflin county, in favor of the county of Dauphin.
