Relative to the destruction of wolves and panthers in the county of Centre.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the provisions of the act of sixteenth March, one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, entitled "An Act to encourage more effectually the destruction of wolves and panthers," be and the same are hereby re-extended to the county of Centre; and that any act altering or changing the same, so far as regards the said county, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Authorizing the committee of the estate of Peter Young, a lunatic, to apply the estate of said lunatic for his support.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* it shall and may be lawful for the court of common pleas of Washington county, to authorize the committee of the estate of Peter Young, of Carrol township, in said county, a lunatic, to apply annually for his support, such amount of said estate as shall be deemed necessary for his safe keeping and comfort.
