AN ACT

Vesting in the trustees of the Baptist church of Hilltown, Bucks county, the title to certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the title to a certain meeting house, grave-yard and lot of land, in the township of Hilltown, in the county of Bucks, devised by the last will and testament of William Thomas, proven and registered in the register's office of said county, October, one thousand seven hundred and fifty-seven, and described in said will, as follows: "To begin at Henry Lewis' corner post; thence south-east somewhat further than the spring or well which belongeth already to the said meeting house, thirty-five perches; thence north-east twenty perches; thence north-west thirty-five perches to a white oak sapling by the great road; thence along the said road south-west twenty perches to the place of beginning, containing by estimation, four acres of land and some odd perches," be and the same is hereby vested in fee simple, in the trustees of the Baptist church and congregation in Hilltown township, in the county of Bucks, and their successors forever, to be held by the said trustees and their successors, subject to the restrictions, privileges, and for the uses, intents and purposes specified in the said devise; and with power to sell or dispose of the same, or any part thereof, free of all encumbrance, whenever in the judgment of said trustees and congregation it may appear advisable so to do: *Provided however,* That in case the said trustees should hereafter dispose of said property, or any part thereof, the proceeds arising therefrom shall be appropriated to the purposes named in the will of said William Thomas, and to those purposes only.

Certain property in the township of Hilltown, Bucks county, vested in the trustees of the Baptist church in said township.
