## AN ACT

To erect a new township, school and election district in the county of Berks, to be called Perry township; erecting the village of Mount Morris into a separate school district; and authorizing the commissioners of Carbon county to borrow money.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the township of Windsor, in the county of Berks, as lies south of a line commencing at a certain point on Schuylkill river, designated by a post on land of George Hughes; thence including the farm buildings of George Hughes, the Zion's church, et cetera, north eighty-seven and a half degrees one thousand seven hundred and seventy-six perches, to a double hickory tree on the banks of the Maiden creek stream, on land of Jacob Heinly, be and the same is hereby erected into a new and separate township, school and election district, to be called Perry township. The qualified voters of said township shall hold their general and township elections at the house of Jacob Boyer, in Shoemakersville, in said township, and Benjamin Gordner is hereby appointed judge, and John Snyder and John H. Mohr inspectors, to hold the first township election on the third Friday in March next; then and thenceforth the qualified voters of said township shall elect such township officers, and at such time as now provided for by law in other townships in said county: *Provided,* That copies of this section shall be put up in at least twelve of the most public places in the new township so erected, and at the place of holding the township elections in Windsor township, at least six days before the third Friday of March instant.

Part of Windsor township, Berks county, erected into a separate school and election district.

Proviso.

**SECTION 2.** That the village of Mount Morris, in the county of Greene, including such portions of the vicinity of said village as are included in sub-district number one, Perry district, and county aforesaid, is hereby erected and created into a new and separate common school district, and as such shall be entitled to all offices, rights, powers and privileges allowed by law to other common school districts, and the election thereof shall be held at the same place with the township election of said village; and the electors of said district shall, at their next election, elect six school directors thereof, two to serve one year, two to serve two years, and two to serve three years. Said election to be conducted by the same officers who conduct said township election; and the successors of the said directors shall be elected in manner directed by law as to other school directors, &c.

Village of Mount Morris, Greene county, erected into a separate school district.

Commissioners of Carbon county authorized to borrow money.

**SECTION 3.** That the county commissioners of Carbon county, be and are hereby authorized to borrow any amount of money, not exceeding six thousand dollars, for the purpose of re-building their public buildings, lately destroyed by fire.
