AN ACT

In relation to the debts of Cascade township, Lycoming county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all moneys in the hands of the treasurer of the county of Lycoming, at the time of the passage of this act, due or belonging to the township of Cascade, in said county, as well as all moneys hereafter received by said treasurer, accruing from road taxes heretofore or hereafter assessed upon the unseated lands, located in said township of Cascade, shall by said county treasurer within twenty days after said taxes, or any portion thereof, shall have been received by him, be appropriated and paid over to the judgment creditors of said township, according to the priority of said judgments, as entered upon the records of the common pleas of said county: *Provided,* That said treasurer shall make said payments according to the laws of this commonwealth, regulating the distribution of proceeds of real estate arising from sheriff sales among lien creditors: *And provided,* That if any adverse claimant or claimants to said money, or any portion thereof, shall within said twenty days, file an affidavit with said treasurer and one with the prothonotary of said county, alleging that his judgment or judgments is or are just, and that he verily believes himself entitled to said money, or any part thereof, also setting forth the amount thereof, said treasurer shall pay the same, or so much thereof as may be set forth in said affidavit, into the court of common pleas of said county, to be by said court distributed according to law as aforesaid: *Provided further,* That the taxes hereafter assessed on the unseated lands in said township, shall not be less than fifty cents on the hundred dollars upon the assessed valuation thereof, until all said judgments, with costs thereon due by said township, shall have been paid.

Certain moneys in the hands of the treasurer of Lycoming county, to be paid over to judgment creditors of Cascade township, &c.
