A SUPPLEMENT

To the acts of assembly incorporating the Doylestown and Willow Grove turnpike road company, and the Doylestown and Danborough turnpike road company.

Doylestown and Willow Grove turnpike road company, or the Doylestown and Danborough turnpike company, authorized to make a certain road.

Proviso.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Doylestown and Willow Grove turnpike road company, and the Doylestown and Danborough turnpike company, or either of them, be and they are hereby authorized to make and construct a turnpike road through the borough of Doylestown, in the county of Bucks, from the termination of the Doylestown and Willow Grove turnpike road at the southern line, to the commencement of the Doylestown and Danborough turnpike road at the northern line of the said borough, or such portions thereof as may be agreed upon by either of the said companies, by and with the consent and concurrence of the chief burgess and town council of the said borough; and that in the extension and construction of the said turnpike road, or such portion thereof as may be agreed upon as aforesaid, the said companies, or either of them, shall have all the authority and be governed by all the provisions and restrictions in their, or either of, their original charters of incorporation, and of all such supplements thereto as have been subsequently enacted, in the manner of constructing and making the said turnpike road, or the amount of tolls to be charged and collected for traveling along and using the same: *Provided,* That nothing herein contained shall permit or allow the said companies, or either of them, to make any alteration in the width or grade of the street over and along which the said turnpike may pass, as the same is now established, without the consent and concurrence of the chief burgess and town council of the said borough, and with the further provision that no turnpike gate for the reception of tolls, shall at any time be erected within the limits of the said borough.
