Cooper, Jacob Abrahams and Alexander Walker, and the survivors and survivor of them, be and they are hereby authorized to grant, assign and convey the said lot of ground, with the improvements thereon erected, and any and every part thereof, to any purchaser or purchasers thereof, in fee simple, or otherwise, free, clear and discharged from all every trust or trusts, and as fully and amply as if the same had been purchased by them individually, and for no other purpose; and without any liability whatever on the part of the purchaser or purchasers, to see to the application of the purchase money: Provided, That before said sale shall be valid in law, it shall have been approved by the court of common pleas of Philadelphia county, and the said trustees shall have given bond, with sufficient security, to be approved by said court, conditioned for the faithful application of the proceeds of said sale.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the president, managers and company of the Fox Chase and Huntingdon turnpike road company," approved the twenty-eighth day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the president, managers and company of the Fox Chase and Huntingdon turnpike road company shall have the privilege of extending their turnpike road from the present termination, at the Sorrel Horse tavern, in Mooreland township, Montgomery county, to Richboro', in Northampton township, Bucks county, with all the rights, privileges and immunities, and subject to the same restrictions, granted and mentioned in said act of incorporation.*
