AN ACT

Authorizing Jacob Weidle, committee of Michael Weaver, to sell certain real estate.

WHEREAS, There are two tracts of land belonging to the estate of Michael Weaver, of Lebanon county, an habitual drunkard, situate in Bethel township, in said county, the one thereof containing two acres and one hundred and fifty perches, under cultivation; the other thereof containing seventy-three acres and sixty perches mountain land, which are unproductive and of little value; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Jacob Weidle, committee of the said Michael Weaver, be and he is hereby authorized to sell the said two tracts of land at public or private sale, and to convey the same to the purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee simple, and to invest the proceeds of such sale, together with the moneys in his hands belonging to the estate of said habitual drunkard, in real estate situate in the said county of Lebanon, as he shall think eligible and proper: *Provided,* That the said Jacob Weidle, committee as aforesaid, shall report such sale to the court of common pleas of said county for confirmation thereby, and such sale shall not be confirmed by said court until the said Jacob Weidle shall have filed a bond in double the amount of the proceeds of such sale, with one or more sufficient sureties, to be approved by the court, conditioned for the faithful application of such proceeds of sale.
